

## MIKLÓS NAGY

### HORN

MIKLÓS NAGY (1963) was born in Budapest (Hungary). He started to play the French Horn at age of seven.

In 1986 he graduated from the Ferenc Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest. His professors included Gyula Gergely, Imre Magyari and Ádám Friedrich. Between 1984 and 1988 he was Principal Horn of the Hungarian Symphony Orchestra and then of the Hungarian State Symphony Orchestra till 1992. Between 1992 and 2000 he was Principal Horn of the Budapest Festival Orchestra. From 2000 september he is Solo Horn of the Orchestre Philharmonique du Luxembourg.

He has also been a member of the Budapest Festival Horn Quartet and first Horn player of the Budapest Wind Ensemble (Octett).

He has had a number of important international competition succeeded :

1985 Geneva (Suisse) 3rd Prize

1986 Markneukirchen (Germany) 1st Prize

1992 Duino (Italy) 1st Prize

1995 Passau (Germany) 2nd Prize with Horn Quartet

From 1996 to 1999 he was appointed Professor of French Horn at the Musashino Academy of Music in Tokyo and the Tokyo Metropolitan Fine arts and Music University.

His first solo CD „Sperger Horn Music” was released in 2003 by Hungaroton Classic.

He has toured in Europe and Japan and has been featured numerous times as a soloist and Chamber player at home on radio and television.
